The International People's College (IPC) is a unique Danish *folk high school* with an international, cross-cultural focus. You can live and study with students and staff from over 35 different countries each term.

The International People's College was founded in 1921 – in the ashes of World War I – to promote international understanding and world peace. Since then, people over the age of 18 from all continents, countries and cultures have had the opportunity to study under the same roof in Helsingør, Denmark.
